一. 目的

- (一) 促進學生主動進行研究、培養學生自學能力,深化學生英語表達及邏輯思辨能力,培養國際 溝通長才。
- (二) 提供北中南東各地師生校際交流與英語辯論觀摩機會。
- (三) 儲備日後參加國際英語辯論大賽之人才。

二 辨理單位

- (一) 主辦單位:國立臺灣師範大學英語學系、國立中科實驗高級中學。
- (二) 協辦單位:英國文化協會。
- (三) 贊助單位:敦煌書局、文鶴出版有限公司。

三 参加對象

參與對象:

- (一) 北中南三區區域性英語辯論賽事活動獲勝隊伍。
- (二) 參與隊伍最多共十二隊,每隊辯士三人、備取一人(賽前若遇突發狀況導致正取辯士之一無法出賽時,可由備取辯士遞補,最遲須於報到時間立刻告知主辦單位。備取辯士可獲得參賽證明。)。參賽辯士應盡量以之前參加區域賽事(即台北西賽羅、中台灣和南台灣英語辯論比賽)之隊伍為主,若有特殊情況,可在原隊伍中做一至二人之替換。
- (三) 參與隊伍不足十二隊時,北中南三區區域活動承辦學校可出兩隊參賽。
- (四) 每校須派指導教師一位,該指導老師亦將擔任本賽事各場次之評審。

「2014全國高中英語辯論邀請賽」活動規則

一. 辯題

That the Taiwan government should make public sex offenders' personal information.

二 活動規則說明

- (一) 活動地點:國立中科實驗高級中學。
- (二)活動時間:103年6月14日(六)早上9時30分開始報到、10時規則說明、10時30分活動開始,遲到之隊伍視為棄權。
- (三)本辯論活動採以下方式:每場比賽由正方一隊,反方一隊參加,每隊三人,時間三十 五分鐘,兩方依申論先後順序,分為正方一辯、二辯、交叉質詢與反方一辯、二辯、 交叉質詢,六位辯士上台順序與辯論時間如下:
 - 1. 正方一辩申論四分鐘
 - 2. 正方一辯接受反方二辯交叉質詢二分鐘
 - 3. 反方一辩申論四分鐘
 - 4. 反方一辯接受正方一辯交叉質詢二分鐘
 - 5. 正方二辯申論四分鐘
 - 6. 正方二辯接受反方一辯交叉質詢二分鐘
 - 7. 反方二辩申論四分鐘
 - 8. 反方二辯接受正方二辯交叉質詢二分鐘
 - 9. 準備時間五分鐘
 - 10. 反方三辯結辯三分鐘
 - 11. 正方三辯結辯三分鐘若參與隊伍未依照以上辯論順序進行,該部分將不予以計分。若前方辯士時間未到即結束時,直接接續下一順序辯士進行。
- (四) 賽事進行中,講台上的辯士禁止與台下隊友及觀眾交談互動,唯被質詢者要求相關資料以回答質詢者問題時,隊友可傳遞相關資料,以利質詢順利進行。
- (五) 場次及正反方:由主辦單位於臺灣師範大學英語系進行場次與正反方抽籤後,5月30日(五)公布活動當日第一、二場次與正反方,第三場次與正反方於活動當日公布。正反方辯士順序可不同,辯士均須依照報名時正反方場次之辯士順序上場(含第三場次),不可臨時更換順序,違者該部分不予以計分。
- (六) 裁判:每場次有三位裁判,將聘請大學教授及高中老師或有相關背景之社會人士擔任 評審。
- (七) 進行方式:本活動採積分制,每場活動各隊最多可獲三分,最少零分。三場次得分累 積為該隊在本活動之總分。將取積分最高之三隊為本活動「優勝隊伍」,若同分時,

將取勝出場次較多之隊伍;優勝隊伍之辯士可角逐「最佳辯士」的榮譽。另外將由評 審會議選出兩隊表現次優隊伍獲頒本活動「評審團獎」。

- (八) 辯論時,禁止使用視覺輔助道具。
- (九) 各隊應準備證據卡(Evidence Cards),以備對方辯士審查佐證資料之用。任何在申論中所提及之證據,皆須有相對應之證據卡,對方辯士可於交叉質詢時提出要求審查某一證據卡或所有申論中所用之證據卡,並當場交由隊友檢視,唯須在該交叉質詢時段後的申論結束時交還對方(建議各隊準備兩套證據卡以因應此規定)。
- (十) 計時方式:辯論當中計時員將舉牌,顯示剩下時間。申論時,計時牌分別顯示剩下二分鐘、一分鐘及半分鐘。質詢時,計時牌分別顯示剩下一分鐘及半分鐘。結辯時,計時牌分別顯示剩下二分鐘、一分鐘及半分鐘。時間到時,計時員將響鈴,之後每十秒鐘響鈴一次,一超過三十秒即強迫下台,超過時間,每十秒鐘扣總分一分。輪到任何一隊做申論、質詢或結辯時,計時員將響鈴,鈴響後該隊應立即上台,若不按時間出場,每晚十秒鐘扣總分一分
- (十一) 攜帶物品:學生請務必攜帶身份證或學生證。辯論時可攜帶字典及資料,活動進 行時嚴禁使用任何電子儀器。

三 活動場地注意事項

- (一) 場地內沒有麥克風。
- (二) 教室內不得飲食,請勿攜帶食物入內。
- (三) 比賽開始後將關閉後門,除主辯單位的工作人員外,禁止任何人出入。
- (四) 為避免影響辯論同學,比賽開始後請勿走動或交談,並請確實關手機。
- (五) 活動進行中請勿鼓掌喧鬧。觀眾席師生與家長請勿與場上辯士有任何交談或傳遞書面 訊息之行為。
- (六) 若欲錄影請於活動前架設完畢,欲照相者切勿使用閃光燈,以免打擾活動之進行。
- (七) 活動場地待安排確認後,再行通知各參與學校。
- 四. 活動當日注意事項

學生請穿著制服或正式服裝,於報到時請學生出示身份證或學生證。

2014 National High School English Debate Tournament

Purpose

- (1) To utilize English debate education for the development of students' critical thinking, verbal communication, and interest in current affairs.
- (2) To encourage research and active learning, thereby strengthening English speaking skills and logical thinking.
- (3) To train native talents for international debating events.

2. Organizers & Sponsors:

- (1) Organized by: English Department of National Taiwan Normal University and National Experimental High School at Central Taiwan Science Park.
- (2) Co-organized by: The British Council.
- (3) Sponsored by: Caves Books and The Crane Publishing Co.

3. Participants and Eligibility

(1) Debaters:

- Winning teams of English debate tournaments in the North, Central, and South regions of Taiwan.
- ii. There will be a maximum of 12 teams, with 3 debaters per team and 1 backup debater. (In the event that any debater has to forfeit, the backup debater shall step into the breach, and the team shall notify the staffers at the sign-in table. The backup debater will receive a certificate of participation.) Debaters should be those participating in the regional championships, but allowances will be made for the replacement of 1 to 2 debaters under special circumstances.
- iii. If the team cap is not met, the host schools of regional tournaments may send 2 teams to participate in the nationals.
- iv. Each school should send one supervisor, who will serve as an adjudicator for the tournament.

(2) Audience:

- i. Faculty members from all high schools
- ii. Faculty members from middle schools involved in this project in Taichung and Nantou.
- iii. Experts and individuals interested in promoting education of English debate.
- 4. Resolved: That the Taiwan government should make public sex offenders' personal information.
- 5. Registration: Registration will be open from 21st April 2014 (Monday) to 2nd May 2014 (Friday) 17:00. Please fax the enclosed registration form to Mr. Shih of the Office of Academic Affairs at (04)2568-7570. Please confirm with the Office by telephone at (04)2568-6850#1230. Should

any team need to replace their debaters or make changes to their order of speaking in the first two rounds, please contact the organizer by 16^{th} May (Friday) at the latest.

 - (2) Venue: National Experimental High School at Taichung Science Park (No.227, Pinghe Rd., Daya Dist., Taichung City)

2014 National High School English Debate Tournament Competition Rules

1. Proposition:

Resolved: That the Taiwan government should make public sex offenders' personal information.

2. Rules:

- (1) Venue: National Experimental High School at Central Taiwan Science Park
- (2) Time: Sign-in at 09:30 on June 14th (Sat.) 2014, briefing on rules at 10:00, and first debate rounds starting at 10:30. Late teams are automatically disqualified from the event.
- (3) The outline of the debate is as follows: Each round will consist of an Affirmative and a Negative team, with three debaters on each team. 35 minutes of time are allotted as follows:
 - i. First Affirmative constructive speech 4 minutes
 - ii. Second Negative cross examines First Affirmative 2 minutes
 - iii. First Negative constructive speech 4 minutes
 - iv. First Affirmative cross examines First Negative 2 minutes
 - v. Second Affirmative constructive speech 4 minutes
 - vi. First Negative cross examines Second Affirmative 2 minutes
 - vii. Second Negative constructive speech 4 minutes
 - viii. Second Affirmative cross examines Second Negative 2 minutes
 - ix. Preparation period for rebuttal speech 5 minutes
 - x. Third Negative Rebuttal 3 minutes
 - xi. Third Affirmative Rebuttal 3 minutes
 - * If any team doesn't follow the above sequence, its score for that speech or cross-examination will be taken off. If the debaters do not use up their allotted time, simply proceed to the speech or cross-examination period that follows.
- (4) Debaters on the stage are not allowed to discuss with their teammates at all times; but during cross-examination periods, teammates can pass the needed evidence to the cross-examinee to facilitate the cross-examination. Violators will be penalized by having his/her score for that cross-examination taken off.
- (5) Matchups: The organizer will draw lots at the English Department of NTNU to determine school matchups for the rounds. The matchups for the first two rounds will be announced on May 30th (Friday), while the matchups for the 3rd round will be announced on the day of the event. Bracket information will be provided by the organizer by then.
- (6) Judges: Each competition will have 3 judges. We will invite professors, senior high school teachers, and individuals specializing in relevant areas to adjudicate.
- (7) Procedure:

The competition will operate on a points-accrual system. For each round, each team may accrue a score from o to 3. The top three teams, ranked by their total points across three rounds, will be the winning teams, and their debaters will contend for the honor of "Best Debater". The Adjudication Committee will also choose two runner-up teams as the recipients of "Judges' Choice Award".

- (8) No visual aids are allowed during the debates (e.g. posters or charts).
- (9) Each team needs to prepare evidence cards for cross examination. Any evidence cited during the debate should have a corresponding evidence card, which may be reviewed upon request by the cross-examiner and their teammates. The card(s) need to be returned at the end of the constructive speech following the cross-examination. Teams are advised to bring two sets of cards for this reason.
- (10) Timing: During the debate the timer will flash cards displaying the remaining time at the following intervals:
 - 1) Constructive speeches: 2 min, 1 min, 30 sec
 - 2) Cross examination: 1 min and 30 sec
 - 3) Rebuttal: 2 min, 1 min, 30 sec

A bell will be rung to signal time, with subsequent rings for every 10 seconds overtime. Debaters will be forced off the stage after 30 seconds overtime. A point will be deducted for every 10 seconds overtime. Debaters will be called to the lectern, and thus must proceed to the lectern immediately. A point is deducted for every 10 seconds of tardiness.

- (11) Debaters must bring their Student ID cards or ID cards. Dictionaries and references are allowed, but all electronic devices are prohibited during the debate.
- 3. Notes:
 - (1) The rooms will not have microphones.
 - (2) Eating and drinking are prohibited in the classroom.
 - (3) Doors will be shut right after the competition begins. Any entry is forbidden except for staff members and coordinators of the organizer.
 - (4) In order not to disturb the speaker, chatting and walking around in the classroom are not allowed during the debate. Please make sure to turn offyour cell-phone as well.
 - (5) Clapping is not allowed during the debate. Members in the audience are not allowed to talk to debaters in the front, nor are they allowed to pass over any information or materials.
 - (6) If you want to record or take photos, please set up your device before the debate begins. Flash is prohibited.
 - (7) Debate classrooms are yet to be announced. Participating schools will be notified.
- 4. Debaters are advised to wear uniforms or formal clothes and shall bring with them their student ID cards.
